Our staff, alumni and volunteers have lived experience and understand the struggles of recovery. You are not alone.

The Brentwood Residential Addiction Treatment Program is a spirituality based and evidence informed program. Our curriculum consists of meetings, one-on-one counselling and intensive group therapy. The Residential Program is between 3-12 weeks and is based on the client's individual treatment goals.

We strive for full inclusivity. All who seek a life of recovery are welcome at Brentwood.

Referrals

Referrals are accepted from hospitals, physicians, psychiatrists, the legal community, unions, withdrawal management, community agencies and employers. Self-referrals attend at the suggestion of family, friends, word of mouth or the information on our website.



Brentwood is staffed by over 50 employees including certified addiction counsellors, registered psychotherapists, nurses, physicians and navigators.

Health Services

The Brentwood Medical Department team consists of Registered Nurses, Registered Practical Nurses, an Addiction Physician and a Psychiatrist. We work closely with our local pharmacy to ensure all medication needs and concerns are met. We will welcome you to Brentwood while working to meet all your health concerns and provide effective continuous care.

After Care

When a person completes the program, they become part of the Brentwood Fellowship. Extensive aftercare services are provided to those in their recovery journey and their families. Graduates from out of town and district are linked to Brentwood's virtual services and resources in their local community.



Addiction affects the whole family.

Family participation is a key component of the recovery process. Brentwood's program and services combines addiction treatment with prevention and awareness to produce the best possible outcomes for the entire family.

Family Support—There is help available for the whole family consisting of groups for Women, Couples, Junior Youth Group and Parents. Men upon request—please call for more information.

Women's Support Group—This group's main purpose is to provide support for women whose family member has been involved in the residential treatment program.

Couples Support Group- Couples relations with other couples, sharing, listening and caring for one another in a supportive environment.

Junior Youth Support Group—This group's main purpose is to provide support for children ages 7-16 whose caregivers are currently in recovery. A variety of topics are covered along with the opportunity to have some fun. Children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
