- All applicants who qualify under the bylaws are interviewed by the Governance and Nominating Committee.
- Candidates are recommended to the entire Board of Directors to support their nomination to stand for election.
- Elections will be held at the Annual General Meeting of the Corporation on October 14, 2026.
